The matter was reviewed again at a meeting on 19 November 2013 where it was found that speed surveys carried out at various locations on the hill showed speed being compliant with the 40mph speed limit and at that time the Traffic Management Officer who attended the meeting said that if TVP were approached to change the speed limit they would conclude that the current speed limit was appropriate and would not support a change.</i>)</p> <p>v.
